

It was really special to be able to take 3 of our young people along to the first Anchored Retreat in the South. What a great weekend we all had! Anchored provided all the usual things you might expect from a camp – good food, fun activities, new friendships, great leaders, lots of laughter.... but Anchored is so much more! In a very personal and intimate way, students alongside their adult mentors were challenged to go deeper with faith and to think about what it means to be anchored in God. This was done in a range of different settings – through team challenges, through creative prayer experiences and through in-depth teaching. Working together as a team, the CFM staff delivered a quality programme and engaged with the students, building relationships with them. They gave us a very positive taster of the whole Anchored course and set us up keen to go back to own church contexts to keep learning together. The whole experience was enjoyable and satisfying in every way. I will certainly be working towards taking another group of students to the next Anchored in the South.


