Volunteers get stuck in

This past month we've been busy getting new volunteers and community members trained up to check trap lines in northern suburbs and around St Clair. It's fantastic to have lots of new trappers coming on board to protect important reserve areas from predators.

Members of the St Clair Golf Club are now managing the nearly 40 traps on the course. This is a unique area to do predator control - it's not every day you get to ride a golf cart from trap to trap! The club spans more than 60 hectares and there are pockets of bush, pine forest and new native plantings. The guys have already hauled out some good catches!

It's been great to recently meet with Flagstaff Church members who have been actively care-taking a local reserve next to the church. The group has been clearing weeds, planting natives and looking after the health of the creek. Now they are ready to start trapping on the reserve! Flagstaff Church is located between Ross Creek Reserve and Frasers Gully. It's great to get these little patches of reserve land looked after as they provide 'stepping stones' for native wildlife.

Nearby, we've been working with some very keen residents who have been intensively trapping on their properties that are coursed by School Creek. So far they have removed almost 600 predators! We've also had trap lines out across Ross Creek Reserve for the past two years and have removed more than 500 pests. And soon we'll be laying traps across the Otago Golf Club.

Connecting pockets of habitat with traps means we're keeping predator numbers low across large areas and providing safe passages for native wildlife to move and live in. It's great to have the local community passionate about getting involved!









Yet, we also know how important it is for the faith development of young people, that they *see* faith being demonstrated by older members of the family, and to be included in those rituals and practices. MATERIALS: -Paper -Colouring pens or pencils -String

ACTIVITY

Make bunting to decorate your home! Cut a number of triangle-shaped flags from some paper. On each flag, draw or write one way that you can serve or love God. Attach to a length of string, and hang it up somewhere in your home where everyone can see it.



PRAYER:

God, help us to keep you in our minds (touch forehead), so that we can love each other (touch heart), and serve you in all we do (touch palms). AMEN!

Reflection Questions:

I wonder, can you name any kings from the bible? I wonder why we call Jesus the King of Kings? In what ways can we love and serve God?

Reflect on your mum, or someone who is like a mother to you!

Think about questions like: What makes her smile? What is special about her? What makes her different from other mums? Your favourite thing about her?" Marble Heart craft: Cut a large heart from thick paper/cardboard. In a shallow dish (bigger than your heart) spray in some shaving foam. Put drops of paint/food colouring on foam, and swirl gently with a skewer. Lay heart on top, pressing down gently before removing carefully. Scrape off excess foam using the ruler, and put aside to dry. Once dry, write some of the things you love about your mum on the heart, and give it to her!






PCANZ CHILDREN AND YOUTH LEADERS' SAFETY WARRANT OF FITNESS
